"China Grove II" is a proven blue water luxury cruising yacht built by Boatspeed yachts in Gosford. The current owner has regularly sailed her single-handed, made possible by extensive hydraulic sail management systems, responsive steering as well as a self-tacking jib. Sheets and lines are concealed providing unobstructed deck space. The enormous lounge and dining areas are adaptable to different configurations to suit many occasions. The accommodation is spacious and luxurious including the full beam width stateroom, 6 metres across with walk around king size bed, 3 metre lounge, parquetry floors and an ensuite with bath.



Professionally built in 2001 with a major refit in 2015 and constant upgrades (find listed below). Work has been carried out by the original trades involved in her build, including Central Coast Hydraulics, Southern Spars and O-lectric, ensuring a reliable continuity of management. Coming aboard China Grove II is a step into the elite league of the super yacht where you can't help but be impressed by bespoke cabinetry, beautiful design, exotic materials and the highly crafted finish.
